## **Agra Risk: Grow a Leader**

Amount: \$2500 and Internship

Criteria: Resume and cover letter stating the following: Has experience in agriculture and has an interest in agriculture and business. Is involved in the community, volunteers, has leadership qualities and is a productive citizen. Academic achievement over 70%. Minimum of one reference letter. Interview with school administration and Agra Risk.

Employment: The selected candidate will also be offered the option to intern with Agra Risk Inc. This is a paid summer position, while attending post-secondary. The successful candidate may have the opportunity to work in Strathmore or Chicago, to gain experience in their field of interest.



## **Catholic Women's League (CWL) Scholarship**

Amount: \$500

Criteria:

- Male or Female.
- Attending post-secondary.
- Regularly attends Catholic Mass.
- How has applicant modeled the Catholic faith?  
(No more than 250 words)



## **Christ the Redeemer Catholic Schools Scholarship (two scholarships available)**

Amount: \$500

Criteria:

- Models the philosophy of *"Leave Not One Heart Behind"*.
- How has applicant's faith in Christ evolved over their time at HCC and what are applicant's plans to continue this in the future? (no more than 500 words)



## **Eagle Lake Nurseries Scholarship**

Amount: \$1000

Criteria:

- Entering post-secondary in a Trade or Technical School.
- Priority given to Horticulture or Agriculture then any other technical or trade.
- Strong academic record.
- Shows leadership capabilities.
- Active in their local community or school.



## Evans Family Scholarship

Amount: \$500

Criteria:

- Must be pursuing/enrolled in the field of Education.
- Is in good standing with the school and is a positive role model for their peers.
- In no more than 250 words explain why applicant has chosen the field of education. Please include what post-secondary school applicant will be attending.



## Lions Club Scholarship

Amount: \$1000

Criteria:

- Attending post-secondary.
- Academic Achievement in English, Social, Math and Sciences - please provide marks.
- School/Community Leadership and Service: Applicants to provide the following:
  1. A brief description of the applicant's involvement in school/community activities as a senior high school student. (250 words)
  2. A letter of reference (including mailing address, phone number and occupation and position of the person signing the letter - this may be a teacher)



## **Magnum Cementing Services Scholarship**

Amount: \$1500

Criteria:

- Attending post-secondary or trade school, academic excellence in math and science.
- A strong work ethic and high level of integrity.
- Explain in no more than 250 words why applicant is deserving of this scholarship.





## Next Kids Scholarship

Amount: \$500

Criteria:

- Has attended a licensed out of school care program.
- or
- Is furthering education in the childcare or teaching field.



## **School Council Extra Curricular Scholarship**

Amount: \$500

Criteria:

- Has over a 75% average in core subjects.
- Attending a post-secondary institution.
- Involvement in two extracurricular activities outside of school (examples: sports, arts, volunteering etc).
- In no more than 250 words must explain the extracurricular activities applicant is involved in.



## School Council Merit Scholarship

Amount: \$500

Criteria:

- Must be in good standing with the school.
- Based on academic merit (works hard, completes assignments on time and has good attendance).
- Models the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit.
- In no more than 250 words must explain how applicant models at least three gifts of the Holy Spirit and how they model academic merit.



## **Strathmore Rural Firefighters Association**

### **Nathan Haase Memorial Scholarship**

Amount: \$1000

Criteria:

- Applicant must be entering the trades.
- Academic excellence and must be used within 5 years.

Money will be received once first session of trades schooling is complete.



## **Strathmore Times Media Scholarship**

Amount: \$200

Criteria:

- Applicant entering journalism, art, or computer studies/graphics and demonstrates a willingness to learn and create.



## **Student Council Fine Arts Scholarship**

Amount: \$500

Criteria:

- Applicant has been actively involved in the Fine Arts; including music, visual arts, drama, or dance.
- The applicant will meet the below criteria and include a paragraph response detailing their commitment to the arts.
  - 1) The applicant is involved in more than one of the Fine Arts.
  - 2) The applicant has been actively involved in the Fine Arts programs at HCC during their entire high school career.
  - 3) The applicant is a leader and demonstrates passion and commitment for the arts.
  - 4) The applicant shows an interest in the Fine Arts outside of school activities.



## **Student Council Sportsmanship Award**

Amount: \$500

Criteria:

- Has played at least one school sport and/or completed PE 30.
- A written response describing how applicant has demonstrated fair play and sportsmanship attitude and values (No more than 250 words).
- PE teacher or a coach to sign and support applicant's write-up.



## **Town of Strathmore**

Amount: \$500

Criteria:

- Applicant to submit one paragraph explaining how they have demonstrated outstanding citizenship within our community.





## **Vic Bodeux Memorial Scholarship**

Amount: \$100

Criteria:

- Student who demonstrates excellence in construction class.
